WICSD Grades 7-12 Reopening Plan Summary

Option 1: Hybrid Model

While Attending School In-Person

BLUE COHORT (Students with last names A to Lin): Attend school in-person Monday, Thursday, remote Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday

GOLD COHORT (Students with last names Linder to Z):Attend school in-person Tuesday, Friday, remote Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday

Before Coming to School

Health Screening

Families will be required to complete a health screening attestation each morning prior to school. We are still investigating temperature checks for students at the door.

Arrival/Dismissal

Students will be assigned an arrival time (7:45am or 8:00am) and an entry door as well as a staggered dismissal time (2:45pm or 3:00pm).



In-Person Instruction

Students will participate in two days (M/Th or T/F) of in-person instruction in all content areas, as well as electives, related services or special education services for those who qualify. Teachers will implement social-emotional learning (SEL) activities to ensure the socialemotional health and well-being of students.



Remote Learning (T/F or M/TH)

On remote learning days, students in the hybrid model will participate in asynchronous learning activities aligned to course essential standards and skills.

Wednesdays

On Wednesdays, students will participate in a synchronous PEAK Support time and will have the option to attend subject-specific "office hours".

Some students may be on campus for additional support, or to access equipment and materials for their specialized classes.

Throughout the In-Person School Day

Schedule

Students will follow their normal A day/B Day 9period schedule.

Classrooms

Students will maintain 6 feet social distancing.

Masks

Students will be required to wear masks at all times, with structured mask breaks during the day, including lunch.

Hallways

There will be no large group gatherings in hallways, common areas, or assemblies. Students will follow traffic flow directions and may carry backpacks.

Lunch

Students will be seated 6 feet apart while eating in the cafeteria. Pre-packaged meals will be offered. There will be no a la carte items or self-serve items.

Materials

Some classroom materials will need to be shared; we will limit this as much as possible and disinfection protocols will be in place.

Music/Art/PE

Instruction will occur in elective areas, ensuring social distancing. Some instrumental lessons may be provided remotely.

Response to Intervention (Rtl) Services


Special education services and Academic Intervention Services (AIS) will continue to be provided to those students who qualify.





Option 2: Full Remote Instruction (FRI) (100% Virtual)

Daily Schedule




Students will be assigned to either the Blue Cohort-attending classes virtually Monday/Thursday or Gold Cohort-attending classes virtually Tuesday/Friday. During their virtual classes, FRI students will use Microsoft Teams to videoconference into their classrooms. Their teacher may dismiss them to independent work after the whole group lesson, before the period ends. Students do not need to videoconference into study halls or lunch.

<u></u>Instruction

Students will receive instruction in all courses, maintaining their participation in our comprehensive program. Some courses may require students accessing materials or specialized programs on Wednesdays, when very few other students are on campus. Teachers will implement activities for social-emotional learning to ensure the health and well-being of students and to promote interaction between hybrid and FRI students. Remote learning will be taught by West Irondequoit Central School District teachers.

Attendance



Grading & Feedback

Grading will be consistent in both the hybrid and virtual models, and feedback will be provided to students in order to apply to their work in order to demonstrate proficiency.

Code of Conduct

The approved West Irondequoit CSD Code of Conduct and student handbooks will be followed.



Extra-Curricular Activities

These activities will be reviewed following the start of school for possible remote implementation. If offered remotely, these activities would be available for students engaging in both the hybrid and remote learning models.



Communication

Regular communication will come from teachers via Remind, Schoology or through Emails. Parents will be provided with access to Schoology, including those courses designed to communicate Grade Level Specific Information at both Dake and IHS.



Technology

We will leverage a variety of technology tools to support students in both models. Schoology is the learning management system (LMS) that teachers will use to house instructional materials and tasks for students. Remind and IC remain consistent communication tools for students and families regarding upcoming events and student progress. Orientation to these tools will be available to families prior to


